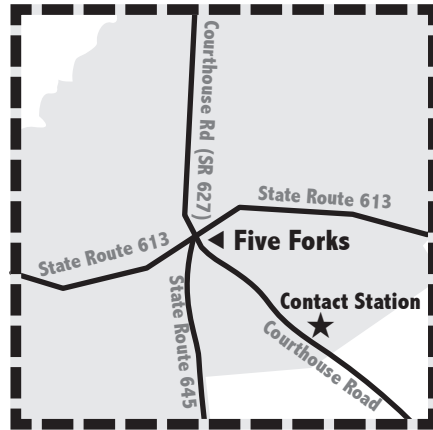

High Bridge

3 miles east of the intersection of Route 45 and River Road at the intersection with the High Bridge Trail

- ▼ Cross the Appomattox River north of downtown Farmville, take an immediate right on River Road, then 3 miles to the intersection with the High Bridge Trail and the Civil War Trails stop. If you'd like to see the site of High Bridge, it's a walk of about a mile south on the trail. The High Bridge Trail State Park is now complete. It's now possible to walk or ride a bike across High Bridge itself.

- ▼ Retrace your steps back to Route 45.

- ▼ After seeing Cumberland Church, continue north until you intersect with the former Lee's Retreat route at Route 636. Turn left on that road to get back on "old" route.
